

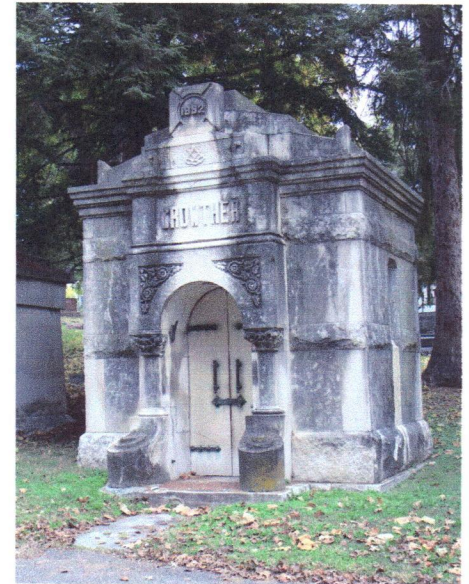

The Mount Mora Preservation & Restoration Association and the St. Joseph Museums, Inc., invite you to enjoy the "Voices From Our Past," as we hear the stories of some of St. Joseph's earliest and most fascinating citizens, now buried at Mount Mora Cemetery. Established in 1851, Mount Mora is one of the city's oldest continually operating cemeteries. On the evenings just before "All Saints' Day," you will see unique architecture and hear the intriguing tales of St. Joseph's former residents. Begin your tour at the St. Joseph Museum & the Glore Psychiatric Museum, 3406 Frederick Ave., then board the bus to Mount Mora for a narrated walking tour to "meet" some of the city's most interesting citizens.

**The activities begin at the St. Joseph Museums, Inc., 3406 Frederick Avenue sites. The 6 p.m. tour will allow you to have 45 minutes to visit the museums and enjoy refreshments before boarding the bus for Mount Mora. The 7 p.m. tour will allow you to have 30 minutes at the museums before going to the cemetery.**

Admission is \$13 for Mount Mora Preservation & Restoration Association members and St. Joseph Museums, Inc., members and \$15 for non-members. Space is limited. Pre-paid reservations are required.
